School Community Council In Action

School Community Councils take actions to engage parents and the community to develop shared responsibility for child and youth learning and well-being, and to fulfill SCC responsibilities within the Learning Improvement Plan.

THE CENTRAL PURPOSE of SCC is to encourage and support the involvement of parents and community as partners to improve student learning and well being. For example, by engaging parents in their children’s learning the council can enhance the family’s contribution to student success; by developing shared responsibility for well-being the Council can mobilize the community’s contribution to student health and social development; and by responding to student personal needs the Council can remove barriers to students’ access to learning opportunities.

EXAMPLE:

SCC may take on specific implementation responsibilities within the Learning Improvement Plan. These might be to inform parents about ways they can help reinforce numeracy skills at home, to establish a literacy program, or to support community agencies in the development of providing physical activities within the community.
